Mr. Scott Reilly's seventh grade students pose after a fun day exploring the outdoors on the High Falls Flowage near Crivitz recently.

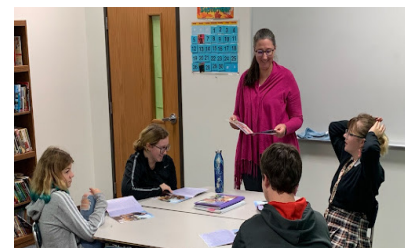
